



## Parents/Family/Friends

In order to ensure a safe, fair, and smoothly run competition, we provide you with the following information about the 2012 USA Junior Nationals at the *Disneyland® Resort*:

- All performers/spectators must have a valid admission ticket to *Disney's California Adventure®* Park in order to participate in and/or view the competition. If this ticket was purchased through the United Spirit Association, then admission to the competition will be included with your ticket. If your ticket was purchased elsewhere or you are using a season pass, then you must purchase a separate competition wristband to view the event.
- Performers should come to *Disney's California Adventure®* Park dressed and ready to perform.
- Upon entering the park, you may proceed to the Hyperion Theater at your squad's designated performance session. The theatre will open for spectator entrance at approximately the times listed (see separate sheet). Seating is on a first-come, first served basis. **There will be no saving of seats permitted at any time during the competition.**
- As a reminder, you must have a color-coded wristband to enter this special event in the Hyperion Theater. If you purchased a package and/or *Disneyland® Resort* ticket through the United Spirit Association, then a wristband will be included with your purchase. **These wristbands are available to the right of the Stage 17 facility in Hollywood Land. The location is between Stage 17 and the Monsters, Inc. attraction. CASH ONLY WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR WRISTBAND SALES.**
- Competition wristbands do not provide admission to any *Disneyland® Resort* Theme Park and/or attraction, only to the competition venue located at the Hyperion Theater. **You must have a separate theme park admission ticket to enter the park.** Competition wristbands do not guarantee specific seating within the Hyperion Theater venue.
- We invite you to enjoy the performances in the division in which your daughter/son will compete, but ask that you enjoy the other attractions inside *Disney's California Adventure®* Park once the awards have concluded for those divisions. This will allow us to more easily accommodate other families who have come to support their performers.
- You may also enjoy the park after your child's performance and return to view awards via large screen televisions from inside the Stage 17 facility if you wish.
- Parents, families, and friends are welcome to enter and exit the theater in between performances only.
- Due to seating limitations, competition participants **will not be permitted** to view the competition from inside Hyperion Theater. Teams may enjoy the park or watch the competition on large screens inside of Stage 17 (between the Muppets Vision 3D and Monsters, Inc. attractions) We appreciate your cooperation in following this rule to allow ample seating for parents, family, and friends of the performers.

**OVER**

- For safety reasons, parents, family, and friends **will not be permitted** inside the warm-up facility and/or in the backstage area. Only advisors/coaches and authorized chaperones may accompany their squad(s) to these areas.
- There will be a USA Nationals Super Store open for competition souvenirs, as well as team photos and DVDs of the competition. These items will be located inside of Stage 17 (between the Muppets Vision 3D and Monsters, Inc. attractions). The store, team photos and DVD sales will close ½ hour after the conclusion of the final awards session or at park closing time (whichever occurs first).
- All parents, family, friends, and participants with competition wristbands may enter this venue.
- *Disneyland® Resort* does not allow guests to bring food/drinks/coolers into the park. There are concession stands available throughout the park. **For safety reasons, *Disneyland® Resort* has a policy that prohibits guests from bringing any type of flammable liquid inside the parks.**
- There are storage lockers available in the park; however, squads are encouraged to leave their bags, etc. in buses or in vehicles. Neither the *Disneyland® Resort* nor the United Spirit Association will be responsible for any lost or stolen items. **All bags will be searched before entering the main entrance of either *Disneyland® Resort* theme park.**
- Video taping of the competition will be permitted; however, for safety purposes, there is to be no flash photography of any kind.
- Team signs may be brought to the competition, but may not be taped on any surfaces.
- Air horns, or other excessive noisemakers are not permitted in the *Disneyland® Resort* and/or the competition venue.
- Any type of behavior that can be interpreted as “unsportsmanlike” may be grounds for a team penalty. This includes behavior in the *Disneyland® Resort* during the course of the competition weekend. We appreciate your support of all teams and your encouragement of proper behavior from all performers.
