**February 9, 2019**

Doors will open 1 hour prior to the competition start time. All teams should report to the registration table no later than 45 minutes prior to the beginning of the division in which they are competing. Two free passes will be allotted to each school/group for advisors/coaches at registration. All **performers** must wear a wristband, provided in your registration packet, in order to enter the competition venue and the official practice area.

Additional spectator or team alternates wristbands may be purchased for \$14.00 (13 and older) and \$5.00 (6-12 years of age). Children 5 years of age and under enter free. Exact change is appreciated. **Cash only – checks and credit cards are not accepted at this competition.** Admission may be pre-purchased for spectators by going to the following website – <https://www.eventbrite.com/e/usa-nevada-open-sat-feb-9th-tickets-49956926512>. For pre-purchased admission wristbands upon arrival, proceed to general admission and show proof of purchase at the expedited "TicketRoar/Pre-Purchase" designated line. You will receive a wristband which will allow you to enter the event. Pre-purchased admission cannot be used without receiving a wristband first. Note that the pre-purchase opportunity is subject to close prior to the event.

**PARKING FEES:** There is no charge for parking. Please park in the Tropicana Parking Structure to the south of Cox Pavilion, as there is a basketball game taking place in the facility adjacent to Cox Pavilion, so parking will be impacted.

Outside food, coolers or drinks are not permitted inside of the Cox Pavilion. Concessions will be available. Cash only will be accepted at the concessions booths.

**There will be no seat saving permitted.** All seats are on a first-come, first-serve basis. As a reminder, the USA and/or the host school/venue will not be responsible for lost/stolen items at the competition. Please encourage team members to leave valuables, bags etc. in their vehicles. **Do not leave bags unattended.** For security reasons all competitors must stay in possession of their bags at all times. We will not permit bags in the facility to save seats. All bags (spectators/performers) are subject to search.

You will need to submit an alphabetized list of all participating performers, as well as a signed USA participant release and waiver form (school and youth/rec teams) for each participating performer. **NO COMPETITORS FROM SCHOOL-BASED OR YOUTH/REC TEAMS WILL BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE WITHOUT AN ORIGINAL, SIGNED PARTICIPANT RELEASE AND WAIVER FORM. WE ASK THAT ALL RELEASE AND WAIVER FORMS PLEASE BE ALPHABETIZED.**

**Every all star performer must be a current registered member of the USASF.** Each team is required to turn in their official USASF team roster from the USASF website at registration on the day of the USA competition. Only USASF credentialed coaches are permitted in the warm-up area with teams. USASF credentialed coach identification must be available for each individual wishing to enter the warm-up area. Go to [www.usasf.net](http://www.usasf.net) for more information or contact your USASF Regional Director with questions regarding this 2018-19 USASF policy.

First aid staff will be on site to provide assistance for emergencies only. Taping of wrists/ankles for individual performers will not be available. Any participant who has a suspected concussion/head injury will not be allowed to return to participation the day of the incident, per Varsity Spirit corporate policy.

Participants and advisors/coaches only will be allowed in the assigned warm-up area and in the "Getting Ready" and "On Deck" areas.

Competition will begin at 8:00 AM. Please refer to the enclosed tentative performance schedule. Please check the USA website ([varsity.com/usa](http://varsity.com/usa)) on the Wednesday before the competition after 5:00 p.m. (PST), for a final schedule. A final schedule will also be available at the registration table on the day of the event. All teams must be ready to perform 15 minutes prior to their scheduled time. In order to avoid a possible penalty, any changes must be received in the USA office in writing by 5:00 p.m. (PST) the Friday one week prior to your competition date. **No changes will be allowed on the day of the event.**

OVER

There will be assigned warm-up/practice time offered for each cheer team. Please be at warm-up check in 10-15 minutes prior to your scheduled check-in time. Teams must report to the warm-up area at the time designated on the "Warm-Up" schedule. Teams will not be permitted to enter the warm-up area earlier than their assigned check-in time. All cheer teams will have the opportunity to practice/warm-up on a carpet bonded foam mats measuring at least 42' x 42' (5 strips). All Star cheer teams will perform on a spring floor measuring 54' x 42' (9 strips). All other cheer teams will perform on a carpet bonded foam mat measuring 54' x 42' (9 strips). There will be a spring tumbling strip available for all-star teams with a specialized warm-up schedule. Ceiling height of the performance area is 30'.

**MUSIC RULES:** Music guidelines are being followed at all USA and Varsity Brands events. Competition music must be properly licensed and a team must provide a printed copy of proof of licensing at team registration. If a team cannot provide proof of licensing immediately upon request, the team may be disqualified from the event. For further details visit [www.varsity.com/music](http://www.varsity.com/music).

A sound system will be provided. Speed control is not available. Music checks on the main sound system are not permitted. A representative must be present at the sound system at the time of performance. Advisors/coaches are asked to hold onto their own music until the time of performance and to take music back following the performance. All teams must provide their own MP3 device (or smart phone) for use on the event provided sound system. Music must be recorded at the correct tempo. Although it is not recommended due to interference that may be caused during a routine, a smart phone may be used for playing music. No cover may be on any MP3 player or smart phone so that a patch cord may be easily inserted into the device. Please ensure that jacks are clean and free of any debris which may impact connectivity. You must ensure that your device has a jack into which a patch cord may be inserted. Note that you may need to acquire an adapter in advance if your player does not have a head phone jack. New – Ability to play routine from a CD **will not** be available.

Spirit and youth/rec teams, please note the AACCA School Cheer Safety Rules, USA Song/Pom and Pep/Short Flag General Safety Rules, and the Show Cheer and Song/Pom Division Limitations posted at [usa.varsity.com](http://usa.varsity.com). Remember that two points will be deducted from the final team average of each occurrence of an illegal procedure. Performance error deductions will be assessed. All Star teams, please note the 2017-18 USASF General Safety and Level Rules for All Star Teams posted at [usasf.net](http://usasf.net). Remember that 0.25-1.0 point will be deducted from the final team average of each occurrence of an illegal procedure. Performance error deductions will be assessed.

All Star teams, please note the 2018-19 USASF General Safety and Level Rules for All Star Teams posted at [usasf.net](http://usasf.net). Remember that 0.25-1.0 point will be deducted from the final team average of each occurrence of an illegal procedure. Performance error deductions will be assessed.

Scoresheets will be distributed to all teams at the conclusion of awards. Only an authorized team advisor/coach who is designated at team registration may pick these up. A photo I.D. will be required for scoresheet pick up. Recaps may be requested via the USA website ([varsity.com/usa](http://varsity.com/usa)) following the competition.

Video Taping Policy - For safety and security we respectfully request that videotaping be limited to performances of your school/organization only. Tri-pods for cameras and/or cameras with a specialized lens attachment may not be used. Again, videotaping is permitted, but only of the routine(s) that are being performed by your participant's team. Livestreaming of the event is not permitted.

Please note that "sister" teams and coaches only will be permitted onto the performance floor area during competition. This is to expedite the flow of the competition and to promote a safe and controlled performance environment. Parents/family/friends are welcome to view the competition from the regular arena seats.

Due to the many crossover participants, performance times have been scheduled as best as possible. We have done everything we can so the teams can make the warm up times at Station #3. However, warm up times may have conflicts and cannot be adjusted.

**USA Spirit Opens are not qualifying competitions for any USA Nationals event.**

Each performer will receive a participation trading pin. Trophies will be presented to 50% of the teams competing in each division. For all first place teams, each individual member on the team will receive a 1<sup>st</sup> place "Champion" T-shirt. For divisions with 2 or more teams competing, first place teams will also receive a Championship banner.

**HIGH SCHOOL DANCE TEAMS**

Penalties will affect placement of teams at all competitions but will not prevent a team from qualifying for the "Championship" division in any of the eligible categories.
